RPL FET Network Origins and Development:

FET Strategy 2020 – 2024

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) should also be an important feature ... (in facilitating accessibility)... ETBs are beginning to demonstrate that RPL can be delivered at significant scale, and the models that have been piloted should now be mainstreamed as this route into education and awards can be a real attribute and selling point for FET in the future

VPL Biennale May 2024

Four concurrent sessions and seven lightning sessions included in final Biennale programme

Acknowledgment that RPL development was largely project based and as a result was disparate and uneven

Opportunity existed for strategic approach to further development on sectoral basis





RPL FET Network Origins and Development:

- Uneven development of structures and practice across ETBs
- Development of a diversity of resources, policies and processes by individual ETBs
- Need for a more formalised 'sharing space' through a formal community of practice for RPL practitioners
- Need for a library/repository identified by practitioners as intrinsic to the adoption and ongoing development of RPL practice in FET.
- Shared space for information sharing and resources to provide a cohesive and enhanced quality-assured approach to RPL
- Underpinned by an approach which is open, inclusive, and learner-centred
